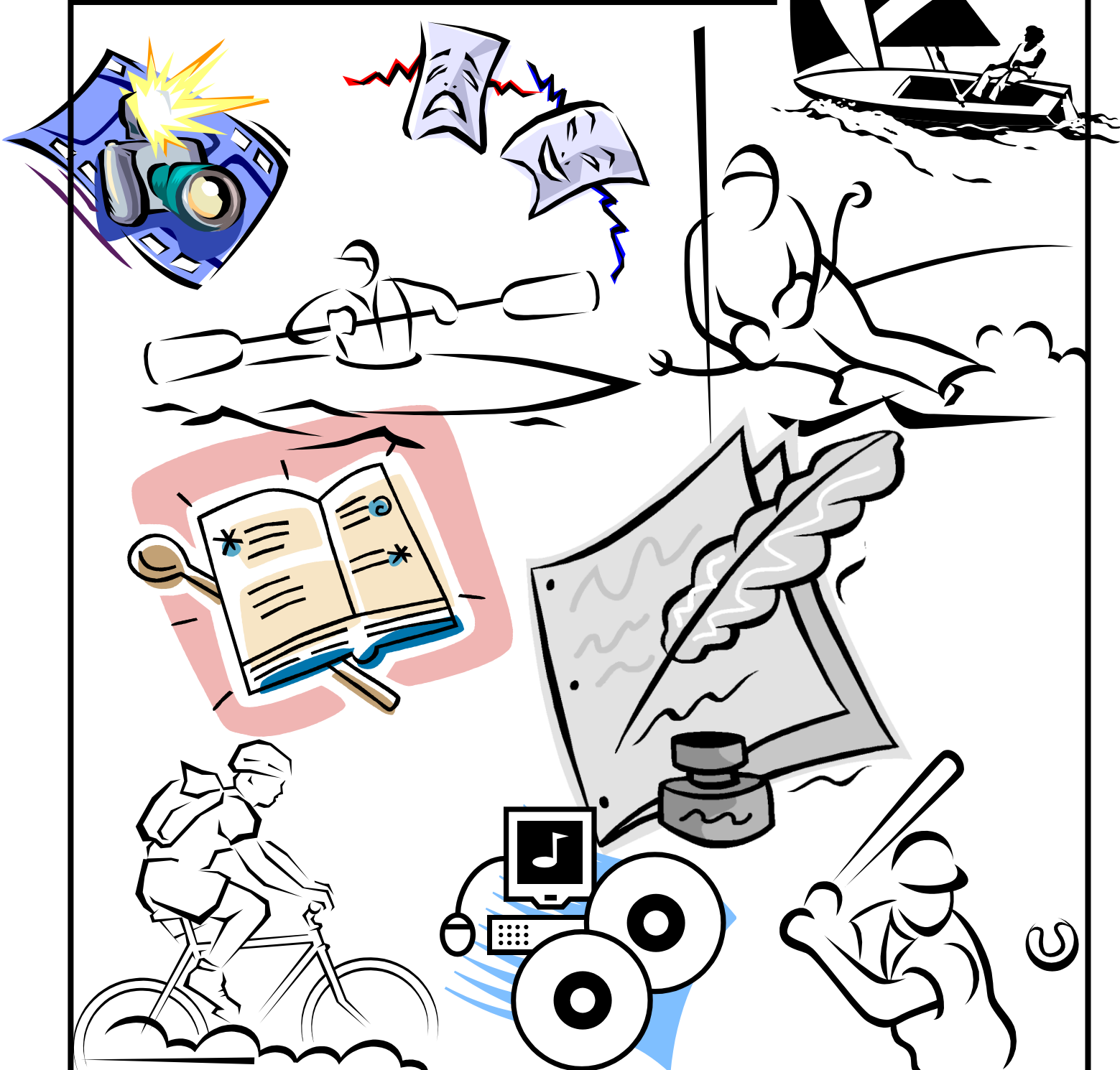

Stage 1 Launch

Activities in this booklet are those which need to be booked now, in order to secure places with external providers. They include all the residential activities and those which will cost over £100. Activities costing £100 or less will be published during March with a booking date in the 2nd half of March. If you would like a place on one of the activities in the Stage 1 launch you should book as soon as possible because they will be cancelled if there are not enough bookings.

The booking date, for ALL years, for all activities in this booklet is;

Wednesday 10th February 2010

Booking will take place in the Main Hall from 0800 to 0830. Students are expected to queue sensibly, fairly and quietly. Any who do not, will be sent to the back of the queue. It will be possible to accept late bookings, however some of these activities are expected to fill up immediately. The times and places will be announced to tutors daily.

This year we will **NOT need to receive a deposit with your booking.** You will be issued with a booking receipt, in the form of a raffle ticket. You should keep this safely as evidence of your place in the queue. Once places are allocated, you will be notified whether you have a place on your chosen activity. This notification will include a payment schedule. Payments will be required on the 1st of each month from March to June (4 instalments). The first payment will be treated as a deposit and will not be refundable unless we are able to recover our costs from outside providers (or our insurers in the case of a confirmed illness, injury etc). By returning a signed form you are making a commitment to take part, places will be reserved for you, and deposits paid where required. If your circumstances change, please contact me, Mr. Lowcock asap.

In the stage 2 launch, during March, you will find many of the usual range of sports, arts, crafts and visits. It is also likely that you will find the following:

Dartmoor Explorers - a mixture of camping, walking and fun activities costing around £50

Surfing - a mixture of surfing and beach games costing around £100

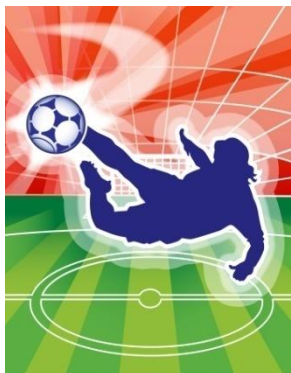
Code: A1

Title: Premier League Tour

Cost: £250

Non-refundable deposit: £70

If you like football you'll LOVE this. How would you like to visit 5 different PREMIER LEAGUE FOOTBALL STADIUMS in 5 days? This is the first time this activity has run and what an opportunity it is! This activity will fill fast!



The week will entail visiting Aston Villa, Manchester City, Everton, Liverpool and Manchester United for a tour of their fantastic grounds and museums. Following this you will have a training session delivered by 4 of the clubs' coaching staff at a training venue provided by the clubs.

One of the afternoons will be spent having fun at Manchester's "Indoor Real Snow Centre". Evening entertainment will range from bowling, cinema and pizza hut. We will base ourselves at a Youth Hostel in Liverpool where all rooms will be en-suite. Travel will be by coach.

Cost: £390

Title: The 1930's Sailing Experience

Cost: £220

Non-refundable deposit: £70

Where? Norfolk Broads, starting at Hunters Yard, Ludham

What? 4 nights / 5 days, traditional wooden boat sailing. Cooking, navigating and sailing.

Who? Anyone, no experience of sailing necessary

Why? It's an adventure! Cooking your own food on board the boat, sharing a cabin with your friends, sailing throughout the day and mooring somewhere else each night, this really will be an experience of a lifetime.

£ 220 to include all travel, food, boat hire, ice-creams etc. No further costs involved.

Learn to helm, quant and rig the craft. Work in teams to lower the mast to go under bridges. Evenings could be spent in rowing races having BBQs or playing football.

Although all involved will wear buoyancy jackets when near the water, students opting for this activity must be capable of swimming 50 metres.

Title: Sailing

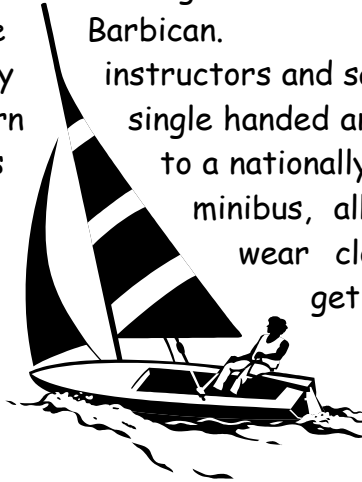
Cost: £155

Group D: Mixed Sport Activities

Activity D1: Watersports at the Mountbatten Centre

Cost: £170

Non-refundable deposit: £50

This is a complete watersports package including all the activities below.

All equipment, instruction, life jackets and buoyancy aids, harnesses and helmets are included. You will need to bring a packed lunch, waterproof jacket, trainers. Wear clothes that will not be damaged when they get wet and remember to bring a change of clothes to go home in.

Sail: Single or two handed dinghy sailing, from Mountbatten. Learn to control the boat then venture out into the Sound.

Kayak or Canoe: Spend the day learning to kayak or canoe and go on a short journey into Plymouth Sound from Mountbatten.

Windsurfing: Have fun learning to windsurf at Mountbatten; wetsuits provided!

Coastal Climb: Enjoy a dry day for a change whilst you climb and abseil, with a view of the Sound.

Coasteering: Wearing wetsuits, climb horizontally along the rocks at water level; can you keep dry?
